LANDSLIDE VICTIMS — They came in droves, lugging their shovels and picks, not to take part in another gold rush, but to help recover the bodies of seven people buried alive in a landslide brought on by typhoon "Aring". The last of the seven bodies was recovered only after four days of intensive digging by the

townsfolk. The landslide victims of Teng-ab, Bontoc, Mt. Province added to the big damages inflicted by the typhoon in Region I and neighboring provinces. At press time, several roads remained unusable, rendering the whole provinces isolated. —Photo by Lee Afidchao
